Inaugural?

"ceremonial investiture with office; act of solemnly or formally introducing or setting in motion anything of importance or dignity," 1560s, from French *inauguration* "installation, consecration," and directly from Late Latin *inaugurationem* (nominative *inauguratio*) "consecration," presumably originally "installment under good omens;" noun of action from past-participle stem of *inaugurare*"take omens from the flight of birds; consecrate or install when omens are favorable," from *in*- "on, in" (from PIE root *en "in") + augurare "to act as an augur, predict" (see augur (n.)).

"ancient Romans functionary whose duty was to observe and interpret auspices. or reputed natural signs concerning future events," 1540s, from Latin *augur*, a religious official in ancient Rome, perhaps (de Vaan) originally meaning "an increase in crops enacted in ritual," in which case it probably is from Old Latin *augos (genitive *augeris) "increase," and is related to augere "increase" (from PIE root *auger*).


The more popular theory is that it is from Latin avis "bird," because the flights, singing, and feeding of birds were important objects of divination (compare auspex). In that case, the second element would be from garrire "to talk." Related: Augural; augurial.

- Seeing is doing anyways...







Interdisciplinary accounting?

- We bring arthropolitical/sociological/historical/critical approaches to study of accounting and its role in life.
- We study the processes of accounting/accountability rather than relying on final accounts as 'facts'

My ways of knowing...

- From strong agents
 - To attention to multiplicity and distribution of agency
- From human centrism
 - To listening to and giving voice to things (numbers, objects, ideas etc)
- From strong separation between knowledge and action
 - To Attention to how knowing becomes doing
- From categories and borders
 - To life at borderlands breaches, leaks, ecotones
- From measurement as representation
 - To measurement as mediation
- From focus on the loud, visible and central
 - Learning to sense the murmurs of the peripheral, the shadowy, the subdued, the silenced
- From study of signs and their construction
 - To listening better to the cries of the signified (patients, ecology etc) through/above/beyond abstract accounts

The makings of the Generally Acceptable Principles and Practices (GAPP)

- How transparency through accounting disclosure and audit
- Was about a "coalition of the unlikely" financial actors the US Treasury and the UAE & Singapore finance ministries / SWFs
- Attempting behind the scenes to subvert national regulation of the SWF financial flows – which was a matter of public concern

A conceptual genealogy of transparency

(With Marie-Laure Salles Djelic)

- From ordo-liberal price transprency for customers
- To transparency of states to/for markets (new institutional economics)
- The new financial architecture of the IMF and World Bank built around 12 accounting transparency standards and enforced by market discipline (fear of capital flight)
- Entrenchment of market discipline
 - Financial capital flows as the new regulators of firms and states
- Standardized transparency and audit enable financial capital as the new "petty" sovereign

Mine-site Assessment Tool

- 1st iteration in 2016
- Idea emerged from frustration during data collection about mines from companies
- And local stakeholder roundtables/demands
- Original idea was scoring of mines by local actors/communities
- Since 2018, use to facilitate dialog between mine-site management and affeced communities
- Has been used in a number of mines in Ghana, South Africa, Indonesia, Mongolia, Kirghizstan and DRC

From financial/social materiality, to 'vital materiality'?

- Taking measurement to sites of impact
- From centralised scoring and aggregation to local experimentation and accountability relations
- ESG measurement/evaluation a dynamic process mediating between different localities/actors
- Leading to smarter and more responsible companies with stronger accountability relations to those affected
